Dr. habil. János Győri is an associate professor at the Faculty of Education and Psychology of Eötvös Loránd University. He obtained his PhD degree in 2002 with a thesis on the *Thinking Skills Trainings for gifted children*. His main fields of research and teaching are: culture and education; acculturation of immigrant students; pedagogy of G/T children; international trends in the education of G/T students; social context of the unfolding of talent; knowledge management and innovation in education policy; theory and practice of literature teaching; development of teacher's work; pedagogical aspects of non-formal education.

In the past 15 years, Dr. János Győri was both an author and editor of more than a dozen specialized textbooks; he published 50 book chapters and numerous communications in periodicals, and held around 100 presentations at conferences in Hungary and abroad.
